## Portfolio Review Guidelines

### Overview

Please make sure that you are registered for a portfolio review. If you are not registered, you will not be able to get your portfolio reviewed. By signing up for the review, you will be expected to talk about what your pieces are, discuss the thought process behind each piece, and ask follow-up questions. ### Specifics

1. The types of work to be viewed are graphic design, illustration, and photography.
2. There is a five piece portfolio maximum. Please ensure that these are the very best examples of your work. If a piece is something you are not comfortable showing, don't include it – even if you have less than five samples.
3. Pieces can be “works in progress,” and sketches are encouraged.
4. Print portfolio items should be mounted (if applicable). If your work is digital (a PDF or website), please bring a computer or tablet to show this work. We will not view your work on a phone.
